- → Lots of Liquid Glue

Water Games:

- → Sprinklers
- → Water Balloons

Office:

- → Laptops, printers, monitors etc. (used is allowed but must be taken care of properly prior and in good working order please)
- → Standard Copy Paper (both white and colored sheets of any color)
- → Card Stock Paper (both white and colored sheets of any color)
- → Pens, pencils, highlighters, permanent markers etc.
- → Sticky notes, note pads, notebooks etc.
