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**All Camper Reminders:**



- Please have your camp docs completed no later than 2 weeks prior to attendance
- Please be sure to print out/utilize our pre camp health screening form 10 days prior to attending and bring it with you to check in your first day of camp
- Please make every effort to be ontime for drop-off and check-in, any arrivals or departures outside of the normal window must be communicated to our office
- As a reminder, only campers registered for horse overnight/mini or horse day camp participate in horseback riding activities
- Label all of your campers belongings
- Do not bring valuables to camp
- Please try not send your camper with cash, utilize our camper online store fund camper account
- If your camper/CIT/LIT is participating in multiple weeks in a row, check out is still Fridays, weekend housing is not offered

- Pick-up is in front of Andrew's Hall M-F from 5:00pm-5:30pm (extended day pick-up is at 9:00pm)



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## Overnight Campers:

- Drop-off and pick-up is in the parking lot in front of Andrew's Hall
- Drop-off is on Sunday's from 3:00pm-4:00pm
- Drop-off will be conducted in a drive-thru manner where you will be directed to stay in your vehicle and follow staff direction through different stations.
- Please double check our packing list located in the parent camper handbook to ensure all required items are packed
- All overnight campers will be required to provide **only one of the following**: proof of vaccination, proof of negative covid test within 72 hours of intake, or proof of positive covid test within 90 day having meet isolations criteria and having been released from quarantine by a medical professional

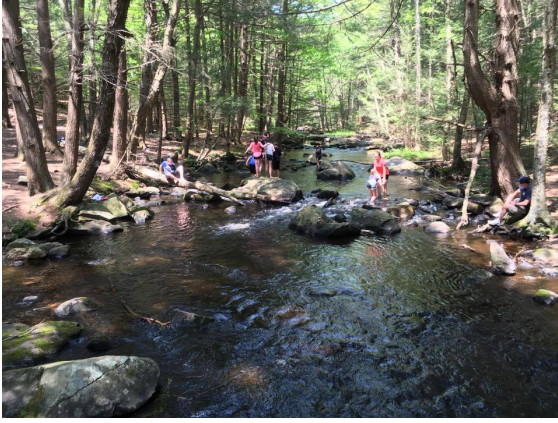

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## Horse Campers:

- Please review our Covid-19 testing policies located in our [2021 Covid-19 Supplement](#) prior to arrival.
- Refer to traditional day camp drop-off and pick-up procedures for day horse campers.
- Overnight horse campers drop-off in front of Andrew's Hall from 1:30pm-2:30pm
- Bring your own horse campers should stop at the barn with their horse from 12:00pm-1:00pm to check their horse in prior to checking in their camper at Andrew's Hall)
- Drop-off will be conducted in a drive-thru manner where you will be directed to stay in your vehicle and follow staff direction through different stations.
- Please double check our packing list located in the parent camper handbook to ensure all required items are packed (Note the specific items for horse camp campers in addition to the regular camper packing list)
- All overnight campers will be required to provide **only one of the following:** proof of vaccination, proof of negative covid test within 72 hours of intake, or proof of positive covid test within 90 day having meet isolations criteria and having been released from quarantine by a medical professional

- If you do not want your mini-camper to be offered the option to stay beyond Tuesday pick-up, please indicate this at drop-off
- Please double check our packing list located in the parent camper handbook to ensure all required items are packed
- All overnight campers will be required to provide **only one of the following**: proof of vaccination, proof of negative covid test within 72 hours of intake, or proof of positive covid test within 90 day having meet isolations criteria and having been released from quarantine by a medical professional
